

**Background Statement:** WI DOC is interested in purchasing secure laptops for use with Higher Education programs and classes on a pilot program. The purpose of the program is to allow students to access current electronic resources housed on secure servers that are either controlled by WI DOC or approved by WI DOC. Students would be able to access new resources stored on the laptop as needed to view within their housing units as well as work within the housing unit and cells on constructed response items to instructor inquiries. The laptops are not network accessible while in the housing unit and must function independent of any network required resources. The unique nature of security within DOC housing units and individual cells requires specific security features in order to work within DOC security policies. We anticipate enrolling approximately 135 students in the fall of 2019 semester across 8 different medium and minimum security prisons throughout the state of Wisconsin with an initial purchase of 150 devices, 80 docking stations, and 150 power cables in addition to those provided with the device and the docking stations.

### Laptop Specifications

#### **Clamshell Laptop Device**

Permanent physical keyboard.

Minimum screen size of 11.6" diagonal

Operating System: Chrome OS or CloudReady compatible. Ability to function without connection to network resources while not connected via a docking station.

Central Processing Unit: 1.1 GHz or better. X86-64 bit compatible.

Memory: 4GB or greater.

Storage: 2.5" 32GB or greater SSD.

I/O ports: Maximum of 1 auxiliary headphone port (3.5mm), one power (12V/3A), and one Docking Connector.

Restrictions: No WiFi, No Bluetooth, No USB ports, No camera, no removable storage.

Casing: Fully transparent. Security Screws, Kensington Security Slot.

Power supply must be included.

#### **Docking Station**

Ports: Minimum of HDMI, 2 USB or more, Ethernet.

Desk mountable to prevent theft.

Power supply must be included.

#### **Warranty Coverage:**

Optional warranty.

Warranty covers shipping costs from the site and to DOC central office at 3099 E Washington Ave, Madison, WI 53704

Repair/replace damaged devices within 60 calendar days from receipt.

Warranty bid must include specific coverage offered related to intentional, accidental, and other person damage.
